Nick and I invite you to review our Recognition Report and celebrate with us our 2018 Fiscal Year accomplishments and successes. It is with pride and appreciation that we look back and remember everyone who has played a part in these achievements.

FY 2018 began with a focus on growing opportunities for the individuals we support to increase their community involvement and participation. We aimed to do this through expansion of our Employment and Day Habilitation Services. Competitive, integrated employment is a priority outcome for the individuals we serve. A job in a community business brings purpose to every day, co-workers who are friends, new skills and confidence, and a much-appreciated paycheck. The greater Carroll business community continues to recognize the value of the skills and work ethic these employees bring their business. A total of 61 local businesses now employ 96 individuals. This expansion enabled New Hope Enterprises to close its doors in February, meeting the Federal Home and Community Based Settings rules.

With the closure of New Hope Enterprises' center-based work training site, the Carroll Bargain Shoppe nearly doubled its sales and receiving floor space. The expansion of the Carroll Bargain Shoppe couldn't come at a more opportune time. Income from the Bargain Shoppes provides important relief to the Medicaid budgetary constraints New Hope faces.

With our desire to deliver more opportunities, we expanded the scope of our service menu to include Habilitation Services. Habilitation Services assist individuals with chronic mental illness live and work in their home and community. This new service has supported five individuals this year to gain jobs with community employers. Research shows individuals diagnosed with a chronic mental illness have a 40% reduction in symptoms when employed.

The Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities (CARF) surveyed New Hope in mid-May and awarded a three-year accreditation for full compliance with its standards of excellence. One of New Hope's accolades stated: "The leadership, management and direct support staff members are personally and professionally committed to New Hope's mission and values. Many of the employees have tenure with the organization, which has contributed greatly to the continuity of services. Long-term relationships with families have been maintained, which has established a high level of trust and esteem across stakeholder groups and the community at large. The corporate culture is characterized by openness, good rapport, and a team approach to planning and decision-making. The board and leadership are to be commended for their excellent financial stewardship and comprehensive planning that have enabled New Hope to maintain financial health and growth despite the challenges experienced by other organizations at the state and national levels. Both the board and the leadership are forward-thinking and community minded."

We are humbled by the *giving of self for the good of others* through the gifts of time, talent and hard work that can be seen in our donors, our volunteers, our Boards of Directors and Trustees and our staff. We have been truly blest, and we thank you for helping us **enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities.**

## 2018 New Hope Highlights

The Annual Recognition Booklet gives us an opportunity to look back at the past year and thank those individuals who've played a role in ensuring New Hope's success for years to come.

### New Hope's Employment Resources Program Grows

In preparing to meet new rules regarding the integration of client work services, New Hope had begun transitioning many of the individuals it works with from New Hope Enterprises to New Hope's Employment Resources and Day Habilitation programs. The goal was to transition individuals involved with New Hope prior to the Centers for Medicare and Medicaid (CMS) deadline requiring providers of work services to clients with disabilities to offer those in an integrated-population setting.

As a result, New Hope's Employment Resources program has grown to support 96 individuals employed at 61 Carroll County businesses. The function of Employment Resources is to find and support community employment for individuals served by New Hope, as well as those referred by Vocational Rehabilitation, schools or other referring agencies. Additionally, the Day Habilitation program currently has 85 people participating in the non-work program.

### Manning Bargain Shoppe Updates Sales Racks and Security



The Manning Bargain Shoppe was fortunate to receive the Warren Timmerman Grant this year, allowing them to purchase new racks and display shelving for the store. With the new display racks, the store has undergone some adjustments and redesign, allowing for more room in many product areas.

Additionally, a new store security system was installed by Drees Co. The security system allows New Hope to monitor the store and exterior, ensuring the safety of personnel and the products being donated and sold. The store's public restroom also received a fresh coat of paint, with more updates planned for the future.

### CARF Accreditation

As an organization that makes providing exceptional care for individuals its top priority, New Hope was proud to announce it had been awarded accreditation through CARF International. The accreditation is the highest level of accreditation that can be awarded to an organization. Organizations receiving three-year accreditation have put themselves through a rigorous peer review process and have demonstrated to a team of surveyors during onsite visits that its programs, services and administration are of the highest quality, and are measurable and accountable.

CARF is an independent, nonprofit accrediting body whose mission is to promote the quality, value and optimal outcomes of services through an accreditation process that centers on enhancing the lives of the persons served. Founded in 1966 as the Commission on Accreditation of Rehabilitation Facilities, and now simply referred to as CARF International. ## 2018 New Hope Highlights

### Perry Shoppe Moves

New Hope's Perry Bargain Shoppe relocated in 2018 to a larger, more accessible store located just north of Highway 30 on one of Perry's main thoroughfares. In addition to the move, the Perry Bargain Shoppe was awarded grant dollars from the Dallas County Foundation to purchase new, larger signage for the store. Combined with the store's proximity to Highway 30, the signage allows customers to easily locate the Perry New Hope Bargain Shoppe.



### Carroll Bargain Shoppe Expands



When one door closes, another opens. As New Hope clients transitioned out of New Hope Enterprises earlier in 2018, an opportunity was made available for the Carroll Bargain Shoppe to expand. The Bargain Shoppe utilized the space previously occupied by New Hope Enterprises, knocked down a few walls and grew their sales floor and processing area by nearly double. This expansion was made possible thanks to the generosity and support of donors and store shoppers.

### Coon Rapids Bargain Shoppe Receives Facelift

Other notable store updates the past year could be seen at the Coon Rapids Bargain Shoppe. After receiving smoke damage in the spring from a nearby fire, The Coon Rapids store was completely cleaned out and received a new facelift. From a fresh coat of paint to renewed flooring, the store received many updates and reopened in relatively short order following the fire. This downtown Coon Rapids store houses three rooms of products and has a unique boutique



### New Hope Receives High Award in Health Care

A standout highlight in 2018 was when New Hope received a deficiency-free survey from the Iowa Department of Inspections and Appeals (DIA). This is a very remarkable and noteworthy achievement in the health care industry. The rating indicates New Hope either met or exceeded the highest levels of federal and state standards in the Intermediate Care Facility (ICF) for the Intellectually Disabled care it provides. Surveyors noted that a deficiency-free rating is rarely given and a facility must meet exceedingly high standards to achieve this designation.

The annual survey is completed by the DIA during an unannounced visit. During this time, inspectors review and monitor client services and records. Staff and clients are interviewed and observed in their daily routine in the ICF homes. Records were reviewed for compliance to regulations on care, confidentiality, cleanliness, clients' rights and quality of services.

DIA surveyors noted that staff were actively involved in providing supports and teaching clients individual skills. They praised the caring attitude of the staff toward the individuals they support and how happy and (seemingly) well cared for the clients were.



## **2017 New Hope Community Appreciation Awards**

**The New Hope Community Appreciation Awards were presented at the appreciation banquet held in November of 2017, to individuals that have made positive influences on the lives of individuals with disabilities supported by New Hope.**

**2017 marked the 40<sup>th</sup> Anniversary of New Hope. The Appreciation Dinner highlighted New Hope's 40 years including the employees who have been with New Hope since the beginning and highlighted some of the first individuals to be supported.**

Rhonda Mart, Executive Director of New Hope, and Mark Burrow, New Hope's very first client, presented the original Board of Directors that governed New Hope's first years, with an appreciation award for their vision, passion and motivation to bring to life the dream of visionaries to develop a "home for the handicap." In 1974, 35 interested citizens from Carroll, Calhoun and Greene counties boarded a bus to visit Handicap Village, known today as One Vision, located in Clear Lake. They returned inspired to develop a "home for the handicap" in Carroll County. Many of those original visionaries who went on that bus trip, went on to serve New Hope as future board members or volunteers. Within a 30-month period, the Iowa cornfield once owned by the Judge family had been transformed into a home for 104 individuals with a disability. Through this Appreciation Award, we pay honor to the 21 living and deceased members of that board of directors. They were the founding fathers and mothers of New Hope and it is certain they could not have imagined how many lives their work would touch. Everyone who came after them are grateful to stand on their shoulders and to continue to carry on the vision of their dream. Accepting the award are Marlene Ambrecht - Rockwell City, Rev. Wally Kinzler - Ames, and Elva Bernholtz (wife of late Lyle Bernholtz), Raymond Free, and Marvin Toft - Carroll.

## 2017 New Hope Community Appreciation Awards

Accepting the award were Tom Louis, Adam Schweers, and Aaron Juergens, Since their very first donation to New Hope in 1976, the Carroll Rotary Club has continued supporting the organization through their service projects. Many lives at New Hope have been enriched by the projects the Carroll Rotary Club has funded over the years. A few examples of these projects include: purchasing furniture, physical therapy equipment including a gait trainer and lifts to

promote safety for those served and the staff, providing disaster pouches, and helping with landscaping. They also helped improve New Hope's ability to support individuals as they learn important work skills through their generous support of obtaining a pallet jack and most recently a baler which is used for processing textiles. As New Hope continued to grow over the years, they stepped up every time New Hope had a capital campaign and supported the remodeling of the campus homes, transitioning clients from on campus to homes in the community, and supported the project for the DMACC Hope Hall to assist with recruitment of employees. The Carroll Rotary Club has contributed almost \$100,000 since they started supporting New Hope in 1976.

Kim Platt, Director of Residential Services of New Hope, and Roger Struble, New Hope 40 year client, presented St. John's Lutheran Church, accepted by Pastor Cindy Johnson, for supporting New Hope's mission of community employment for over 25 years. St. John's has also provided support to New Hope by allowing them to use their Parish Hall for Advocacy meetings and as a training space when there was not an area large enough. Currently there are individuals that attend their Wednesday night Community Meal which offers a chance to enjoy fellowship, experience the spirit of giving through a communal meal, and the opportunity to socialize with others in the community. St. John's was one of New Hope's first partners in providing individuals an opportunity to experience employment in the community. Over the years, at least 20 individuals began their employment at St. John's and a number of these people have gone on to be employed independently in the community at various businesses because of the skills they learned through the partnership New Hope has had with St. John's.

## Charitable Giving Opportunities

The New Hope Village Foundation was established in 1987 as the fund-raising arm of New Hope. The Board of Trustees provides governance to the New Hope Foundation.



Donations play a very important part in providing high quality services to persons with disabilities.

While basic levels of operational needs and services at New Hope are covered by government funding programs, there is often not enough to cover equipment, furnishings and other capital improvements that meet New Hope's standards for high quality service.

Several special funds are available through the Foundation to help donors give more effectively and provide a better choice for contributions.

### Your gifts can be designated to any of the following funds:

- **Annual Fund:** The Annual Support Program pays for recurring needs, such as adaptive equipment, vocational supplies and programming, and capital expenditures at New Hope and its off-campus sites.
- **Building and Equipment Fund:** The fund pays for new buildings, renovations, repair and replacement of equipment, grounds improvement, and other major expenditures at New Hope and its off-campus sites.
- **Endowment Fund:** The fund was established to provide a supplemental source of income to support the strategic plan. It provides the donor the opportunity to make a gift that will keep on giving and will help New Hope save for the future.

Funds received from planned gifts such as bequests, life insurance, retirement funds and memorial gifts go 100% to the Endowment Fund unless otherwise designated.

- **Staff Support Fund:** This fund was developed to assist in rewarding our current experienced and compassionate workforce, in addition to recruiting new talent to provide services for our clients so they may experience an enriched quality of life, meaningful work, expanded social opportunities, support and safety.
- **Client Special Needs Fund:** This fund was established to provide for personal needs of our clients when there are no other funds available.
- **Frank H. Hermsen Staff Development Fund:** This fund provides our staff members with opportunities for expanded training and development. The development of this fund allows a greater number of New Hope's current and future leaders the opportunity to advance their knowledge, skills, and abilities.

Gifts of cash and materials are always needed and welcome to assist New Hope in continuing the excellence in services due to the people we serve.

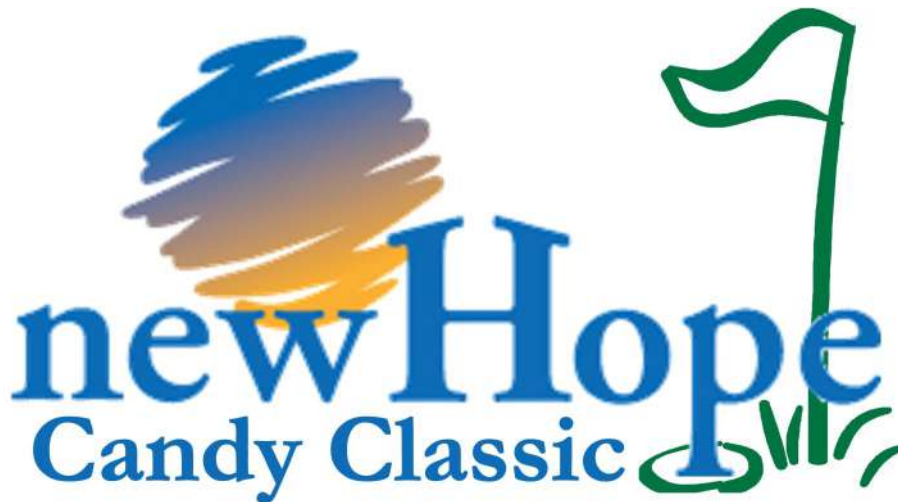
