Celebrating a Rich History

Founded in 1977, the groundwork to bring the New Hope vision to life started much earlier than that. Dating back to the first informal coffee conversation in 1974, a tour of Clear Lake's *Handicap Village* later that year, and a formal election of directors in 1975. Throughout all of New Hope's history, one thing has remained constant... the organization's never ending mission to enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities.

On February 1, 1977, the first 17 residents moved into Cottage 1 (today called Daisy Lane), at our 18th Street Main Campus site. The remaining on-campus homes became occupied later that same year. Of those individuals that first moved into Cottage 1 back in February 1977, four of them are still with us. In total, nine individuals that moved into New Hope services in 1977 are still here at New Hope! Mark Burrow, who was "client #1" back on February 1, 1977, is still here today and very proud of his #1 status. The other eight individuals celebrating 45 years with New Hope in 2022 include: Jeanne, Peggy, Lynda, Mark, Mike, Hollie and Lisa.

Today, New Hope is home to more than 200 individuals with various disabilities receiving a variety of services. New Hope's five main service lines include On-Campus Residential, Community Residential, the *Connections* Program, Employment Resources and Intermittent or Hourly Services.

Commemorating this year's anniversary, New Hope was the proud recipient of the Carroll Chamber of Commerce's Heritage Award. The award recognizes and honors a Carroll area business that has played an integral role in making Carroll the community it is today. Through New Hope's commitment to the local community and community inclusion, the organization has embedded itself into the local community in the most positive way.

Other anniversary events in 2022 included a Chamber Coffee and Ribbon Cutting in early February, nearly 45 years to the day from our first clients moving into New Hope. In June, New Hope's management team planted an anniversary crabapple tree on-campus, just as leaders did 45 years ago when first opening New Hope. And in September, an anniversary week included an ice cream social honoring our 45 year individuals, a luncheon for New Hope 45 year employees, theme days and events, a grand community picnic and New Hope's 2nd Annual Color Round. With the celebrations now coming to a close, New Hope is eagerly anticipating the successes ahead in the next 45 years.

A Place to Call Home:

New Hope Residential Services

The primary focus of New Hope founders 45 years ago, and the largest presence New Hope maintains today, is residential services. These services are the foundation which New Hope was built on. From on-campus to the community homes, these residences provide a comfortable, safe place to call home for nearly 140 individuals. These homes embody New Hope's mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities as they provide a platform for those New Hope serves to live their lives, independently and with dignity.

New Hope adapts each living situation to suit a person's needs, understanding that no two individuals are the same. New Hope teams work diligently to ensure roommates are well paired, and physical and medical needs are accommodated, including wheelchair assistance, communication devices or other adaptive equipment needs. This personalization helps ensure each individual will be comfortable, and successful, in a home best suited for their needs.

On Campus Living

New Hope's main campus offers residents a close-knit community to call home, complete with walking paths, flowers and garden areas. The open campus area offers room for outdoor activities, day habilitation programs, games and sports. Throughout the year visitors are greeted by a clean and well maintained campus, often decorated for the various seasons and holidays.

For those living on campus, each morning they're able to wake up in their own room, enjoying privacy, a comfortable living space and their own personal decorations and treasures. Each home, both on campus and in the community, is kept clean, well decorated and pleasant to come home to when the day is done. Campus programming also includes day service programs and on-campus access to physical, occupational and speech therapies, as well as a 24/7 nursing team.

On campus homes are certified Intermediate Care Facilities for individuals with intellectual disabilities and others.

Community Living

Community homes and apartments are maintained and cared for by New Hope in the Carroll and Glidden communities. Community homes allow individuals within New Hope's care to live inclusively in their local communities. Some homes may be staffed 24-hours a day, while other homes are staffed during the day and utilize a remote monitoring system, known as the Night Owl Support System, to allow individuals to live independently through the evening or at various times throughout the day. Providing individuals this increased independence and dignity as adults with disabilities contributes to the individual's overall wellbeing, allowing them to succeed both physically and mentally.

Individuals within New Hope's Community Living program receive daily assistance with meal preparation, medication administration support, financial support and transportation. Additionally, New Hope services also assist with vocational and employment support, rounding out an individual's opportunity for success in their community.



Connections Program: Connecting People through Inclusivity



Just as the name suggests, New Hope's *Connections* program is designed to connect individuals with disabilities to their local communities. Through inclusive activities, volunteer efforts and programming, individuals enrolled in the *Connections* program have an opportunity to participate in their local communities as peers, participating in local events, volunteering with Meals on Wheels, visiting local fairs and rolling strikes at the bowling alley, just to name a few. Each of these activities provide an opportunity for individuals to learn new skills, or practice skills they've already been working on, while simultaneously working toward greater community inclusion.

Over the past year, individuals have visited the Clay County Fair, Reiman Gardens in Ames, made several trips to Audubon for bowling, frequented Fridley Theaters in Carroll, and volunteered with Meals on Wheels. The team at *Connections* are always looking at new venues for participation and new opportunities for involvement.



New Hope's *Connections* program is geared toward individuals with intellectual disabilities, brain injury or chronic mental illness who might be looking for an environment where they can learn social skills, grow friendships, gain responsibilities and learn life skills. Participants are generally ages 16—88+.

A wide variety of activities are offered in the *Connections* program including volunteering, day trips and recreational outings. Skills activities are also planned based on goals established through Individual Service Plans (ISP). These ISP's are developed with the participant, their family and New Hope's support team. The plan is updated regularly to assess how an individual is doing in meeting their goals and to stay relevant to the participant's personal growth.



Home Support & Services: Promoting Independence at Home

In some instances, fulfilling the New Hope mission of enriching lives means providing minimal assistance for optimal independence. And this is where New Hope's Home Support & Services comes in. Rather than providing round-the-clock, or even daily, services, the Home Support and Services program offers intermittent or drop-in services to individuals with disabilities who are living independently. In many cases, they have their own home or apartment, and simply need a hand here or there with various tasks.

The goal of this program is to support individuals living in their own homes or in their family home, placing a strong emphasis on skill building and community involvement. These services support people of all ages with varying abilities and needs.

What can you expect from Home Support and Services?

- Guidance in maintaining a home
- Budgeting, paying bills and gaining financial skills
- Personal appearance and hygiene
- Independently taking medication
- Shopping
- Participating in the local community
- Accessing transportation and options for greater mobility

New Hope works closely with individuals, their families and support networks to develop a customized support plan based on a person's skills, interests and dreams. We review and revise the support plan as new skills are gained and interests or dreams change.

Additionally, individuals receiving Home Support & Services often also utilize services provided by New Hope's Employment Resources program, assisting them in achieving the goal of maintaining successful employment.



Employment Resources: Providing Purpose

The smiles generated through successful employment matches can be seen all around our local communities, by individuals who've found their purpose with support provided by New Hope's Employment Resources program. The team in Employment Resources understands that the purpose found through gaining employment is important for everyone, particularly those in this program.

Employment Resources provides job training and placement for individuals with disabilities for supported or independent employment that accentuates their skills and interests. For an individual who has expressed interest in finding a job, the process begins with identifying abilities and skills. In some cases, an Employment Resources Job Coach may work with the individual to hone those skills.

From there, the Employment Resources team works with businesses to develop opportunities, providing work at competitive wages, for individuals with disabilities. In some cases, an individual may be able to fill a current opening at a local business. In other cases, the Employment Resources team has successfully worked with businesses to identify tasks that could be completed by an individual and carved out a specific job around those tasks, freeing up current business employees to focus on other things. Either way, the Employment Resources team is committed to finding the perfect match between dedicated workers and employers looking to build a strong workforce.

Currently, New Hope works with 43 businesses in a 45-mile radius, providing employment opportunities for 70 individuals with disabilities.

Together We Are Better

As the old adage reminds us, it often “takes a village.” New Hope is fortunate to have that type of support within our local communities, thanks in part to a large roster of dedicated and philanthropic community partners. Through *Connections* Program, New Hope works to integrate individuals with disabilities in the community as often as possible. One significant activity individuals participate in is volunteer efforts. Building the Next 45 Years

And as we celebrate an amazing 45 year history, New Hope is also eagerly looking to the future. New Hope is poised for growth, in several areas. Strategic growth, combined with careful utilization of the organization's resources, will ensure New Hope is able to continue its mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities well into the future.

Growing Hope

In 2022, an internal exploratory committee began discussing the benefits of an on-campus daycare option for employees. After careful consideration, plans have moved forward to construct and open Growing Hope, a daytime into evening daycare center for children ages six weeks through 12 years of age.

As an inclusive childcare center, Growing Hope will benefit New Hope employees, as well as provide opportunities for the local community to access childcare as needed and into the evening. In addition to serving children of New Hope employees, Growing Hope will focus on supporting children with disabilities. The center will offer full-time, part-time, and drop-in care, as well as before and after school programming and a summer program.

Growing Hope will be located in the Activity Building on New Hope's main campus. The center will be fully licensed and open for children beginning mid-2023.



Atlantic Expansion

Another exciting growth opportunity for New Hope is the expansion of its Bargain Shoppes. The Bargain Shoppes are designed to support New Hope's mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities by providing an additional source of revenue for the organization to support its programs.

In November 2022, New Hope opened a fifth year-round Bargain Shoppe in Atlantic. This 26,000 square foot store will serve as a second anchor store in the Bargain Shoppe family. The store is set-up to mirror the Carroll store in both size, layout and design. Additionally, the addition of this fifth store will aid in bolstering New Hope's textile recycling program, as well as support donations for the New Hope Christmas Boutique, open during the holiday season in Carroll's Westgate Mall.

The Atlantic Bargain Shoppe is open for donations and shopping seven days a week. Its convenient location off a major highway in the midst of Atlantic provides easy access for both donors and shoppers.

An official grand opening and ribbon cutting is scheduled for January 2023.



2021 Community Awards

Annually, New Hope recognizes people and organizations that go above and beyond in their support of New Hope and its mission to enrich the lives of individuals with disabilities. This recognition comes in the way of New Hope's Annual Community Awards.

Traditionally, New Hope presents its Community Awards to deserving recipients at its November Recognition Dinner. In 2021, that dinner was held as a drive-thru. Award recipients were later surprised with their Community Award at their place of business. In 2021, New Hope recognized two very deserving community members: Kevin Reincke, Culvers of Carroll, and Angie Killeen, Natural Look Style Salon.

As owner of Culvers, Kevin Reincke has supported New Hope for many years, in many ways. For the past two years, he has supplied ice cream treats for participants in New Hope's Color Round events. One of the greatest supports Reincke provides is working with New Hope's Employment Resources program. Through Employment Resources, Reincke employs three individuals with disabilities. As a supervisor and boss, Reincke takes interest in his employees, rewards them for their achievements and truly wants to see everyone be successful.

Angie Killeen, of Natural Look Style Salon, is New Hope's other 2021 Community Award recipient. During the height of the pandemic, and during a time that New Hope and the individuals it supports were staying in, Killeen would spend many of her days off at New Hope, providing hair cuts and care to those who couldn't otherwise go to get this taken care of. What others might consider a simple haircut was more than that to individuals at New Hope who were quarantining during the pandemic. For those at New Hope, Angie's going above and beyond was a major self-esteem and morale boost during a critical time.

New Hope congratulates both Kevin Reincke and Angie Killeen for their award recognition, and thanks for them for their service and support of the New Hope mission. Congratulations and thank you, Kevin and Angie, for furthering the organization's mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities.



Developing the New Hope Mission

New Hope's Development Department supports the organization's mission through fundraising, grant opportunities and development programs.

The Development Department works directly with and for the New Hope Foundation. The Foundation was established in 1987 as the fundraising arm of New Hope. The Board of Trustees provides governance to the New Hope Foundation.

The Development Department choreographs fundraising events, appeals and one-on-one requests throughout the year. In fiscal year 2022, New Hope hosted its 14th Biennial Charity Quilt Auction. In 2021, the event had been held online, so in April 2022 attendees were delighted to enjoy the event in-person again. The 14th Biennial event once again brought in a record amount of dollars to help support New Hope's mission.

Other events during the year included the annual Cookies Rib Wagon fundraising events, and the 41st Annual Volunteer Soup Day event.

Additionally, the Development Department spends a good deal of time working with individual donors, ensuring that their personal goals are met when contributing to New Hope's mission. Donations are key to providing high quality services to persons with disabilities. While basic levels of operational needs and services at New Hope are covered by government funding programs, there is often not enough to cover equipment, furnishings and other capital improvements that meet New Hope's standards for high quality service.

Additionally, New Hope works diligently to explore grant opportunities that align with the organization's mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities. Over the past fiscal year, New Hope was fortunate to receive grant dollars from several area grant organizations, including the American Legion of Iowa Foundation the Carroll Rotary Club #2236 and the WalMart Community Grant Program.

During the holiday season, the Development Department coordinates the efforts of area businesses, organizations and families wanting to make a positive impact on the individuals New Hope supports during this important season.

One of New Hope's most visible fundraising efforts are the six Bargain Shoppes. These Bargain Shoppes are located in Atlantic, Carroll, Coon Rapids, Jefferson and Perry, with a Christmas Boutique also located in Carroll. The proceeds from these stores also further New Hope's mission, while simultaneously helping to enrich local communities by offering low-cost, quality goods.

Moving forward, the Development Department will continue to explore new avenues of support for New Hope and the New Hope Foundation, while continuing efforts and fundraising events that are already underway.



Supporting New Hope

New Hope offers a variety of charitable giving opportunities to assist individuals interested in supporting New Hope's mission of enriching the lives of individuals with disabilities. Charitable Giving Opportunities

Several special funds are available through the Foundation to help donors give more effectively and provide a better choice for contributions.

Your Gifts Can be Designated to Any of the Following Funds

Annual Fund: The Annual Support Program pays for recurring needs, such as adaptive equipment, vocational supplies and programming, and capital expenditures at New Hope and its off-campus sites.

Building and Equipment Fund: The fund pays for new buildings, renovations, repair and replacement of equipment, grounds improvement, and other major expenditures at New Hope and its off-campus sites.

Endowment Fund: The fund was established to provide a supplemental source of income to support the strategic plan. It provides the donor the opportunity to make a gift that will keep on giving and will help New Hope save for the future. Funds received from planned gifts such as bequests, life insurance, retirement funds and memorial gifts go 100% to the Endowment Fund unless otherwise designated.

Staff Support Fund: This fund was developed to assist in rewarding our current experienced and compassionate workforce, in addition to recruiting new talent to provide services for our clients so they may experience an enriched quality of life, meaningful work, expanded social opportunities, support and safety.

Client Special Needs Fund: This fund was established to provide for personal needs of our clients when there are no other funds available.

Frank H. Hermesen Staff Development Fund: This fund provides our staff members with opportunities for expanded training and development. The development of this fund allows a greater number of New Hope's current and future leaders the opportunity to advance their knowledge, skills and abilities.
